

BASMAH ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA as per GC 01-2022 with Diagnosis of BREAST, COLORECTAL & CERVICAL CANCER



Insured members holding a residence visa issued from the Emirate of Dubai with validity of not less than one year



The mandate for coverage of Cancer is applicable only for insured LSB members, holding valid insurance policies or policies issued after the launch date of the mandate, with diagnosis of Cervical, Breast or Colorectal cancer, subject to eligibility and treatment criteria being met.



The above would apply for existing and new residents in the Emirate of Dubai who are not diagnosed with cancer before entering the country.



Existing and new residents who were diagnosed with cancer prior to entering the country will become eligible for enrolment only after one year of residence in UAE.



Eligibility for enrollment into the program will be based only on confirmed Diagnosis from the Centre of Excellence(CoE)

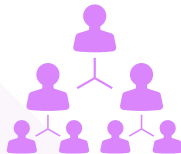

ELIGIBILITY FOR BREAST CANCER SCREENING



All females aged 40-69 years old



Strong family history or genetic predisposition (male/female).



Healthy women who have free symptoms are eligible for screening mammogram.



Previous treatment with chest radiation at age younger than 30.



Previous history of Breast Cancer.



Lobular carcinoma in situ (LCIS) or Atypical ductal hyperplasia (ADH) or Atypical lobular hyperplasia (ALH), on previous breast biopsy.

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PREVENT BREAST CANCER

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ELIGIBILITY FOR COLORECTAL CANCER SCREENING



Male & Female aged 40-75 years old

- No history of inflammatory bowel disease
- No history of adenoma or Colorectal Cancer
- Negative family history
- Colonoscopy, every 10 years: or Fecal Immunochemical Test (FIT) every two years



Personal history of adenoma, sessile serrated polyp (SAP) ** Colorectal Cancer, Inflammatory Disease



Positive family history of first or second-degree relative with Colorectal Cancer (screening recommendations vary depending on family history)



Hereditary Non-polyposis Colo-rectal Cancer (HNPCC) and Polyposis syndromes (Classical Familial Adenomatous Polyposis (FAP-1), Attenuated Familial Adenomatous Polyposis (AFAP-1), MYH associated Polyposis (MAP-1), Peutz - Jeghers Syndrome (PJS-1), Juvenile Polyposis (JPS-1), Hyperplastic Polyposis Syndrome (HPP-1)

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PREVENT COLORECTAL CANCER

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ELIGIBILITY FOR CERVICAL CANCER SCREENING



Aged 25-65 years (married, divorced, widowed) residing in UAE, except where exclusion criteria for screening apply



All sexually active women



Symptom free



Women who have had subtotal hysterectomy (preserving the cervix) or hysterectomy due to cervical cancer or precancerous



Repeat of screening for average risk, symptom free women:

- Aged 25-49 every 3 years
- Aged 50-65 every 5 years
- Immune-compromised due to disease or medication every 1 year/annually



Women are excluded from screening if:

- Received a total hysterectomy for benign indication
- Aged over 65 years have three negative smear for the last 3 years



Screening recommendations remain the same regardless of whether or not they have received the HPV vaccination and with abnormal results or physical examination to a diagnostic or treatment centers

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PREVENT CERVICAL CANCER

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Hepatitis B and C Patient Support Program

Eligibility criteria

The Program is available only for insured members holding a residence permit issued from the Emirate of Dubai of validity of not less than one year



The mandate for coverage of Hepatitis B and C is applicable only for insured members, holding valid policies issued after the launch date of the mandate, subject to eligibility and treatment criteria being met



The mandate would apply for existing residents and new residents in Dubai who were not diagnosed with Hepatitis B or C before entering the country. Existing and new residents who were diagnosed with Hepatitis B or C prior to entering the country will become eligible for enrollment only after one year of residence



Eligibility for enrollment into the program will be based only on confirmed Diagnosis from the Centre of Excellence (CoE)
